Year 2	History Topic .
Year 3	Mapping skills, plans, areal views and scale enquiries. Continents and countries by enquiry, their key features. Atlas skills continued. Local places, school mapping.
Year 4	Using Kenya and the UK, Nairobi and London as a learning vehicle, topic enquiries include: Studies of how environments vary in terms of landscape, land use and climate. Exploring the relationships between people and their environment in the two comparison countries.
