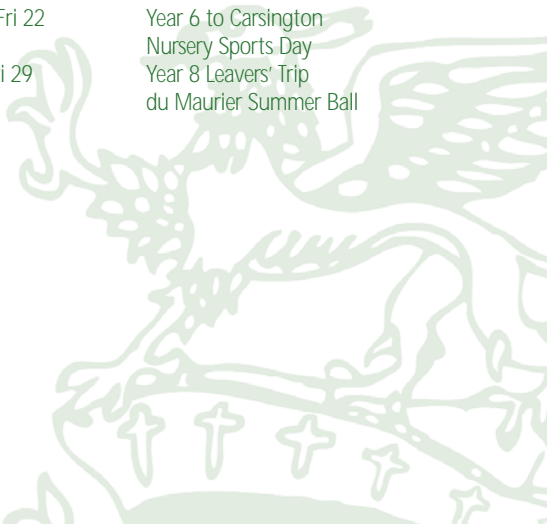

# Values and Behaviour

Heath Mount School regards our five core values as guiding principles and we expect to see these values reflected in the relationships between people, and in the behaviour of our pupils.

The following table is intended to help pupils to understand how each value can be nurtured through their behaviour.

VALUE	ASSOCIATED BEHAVIOUR
Integrity:	be honest even when it is difficult; wear your uniform smartly – take pride in your school; be loyal to your friends; stand up for those in need of support, perhaps by seeking the help of prefects or teachers; your conduct should be a credit to you, your school and your family.
Respect:	be polite to adults; be polite to fellow pupils; be polite to your parents; stand to one side for adults to pass on stairs and in doorways; respect your opponents in matches; treat the building with care; look after your possessions.
Tolerance:	understand that others will make mistakes; encourage those who are less able than you; enjoy learning about the lives of other people; understand that it is fine for your friends to have different opinions to you.
Industry:	arrive to lessons on time and with the right equipment; settle to your work quickly; ask for help when you are stuck; never settle for a standard below that of which you are capable; take pride in your books.
Achievement:	know what you must do to improve in each subject or activity – keep a small list of targets; know what your teachers expect you to achieve – and deliver! Talk to your teachers about your learning so that they can better support you.
