Year 4	<p>Main online resource – Pearson’s Accès Studio</p> <p>Meeting and greeting people, spelling in French, counting and revision of numbers, saying how old you are and asking others for their age. The days of the week and the months of the year, saying when your birthday is.</p> <p>Weekly vocabulary tests start from half term. There are also end-of-unit assessments</p>
Year 5	<p>Main online resource – Pearson’s Accès Studio</p> <p>Meeting and greeting people, spelling in French, counting and revision of numbers, saying how old you are and asking others for their age. The days of the week and the months of the year, saying when your birthday is. Saying what is in your school bag, identifying classroom objects. Using the indefinite article (un/une) and masculine/feminine nouns, plurals, including the indefinite article ‘des’ (some) and describing the classroom.</p> <p>Vocab lists put on SMHW weekly using Quizlet. Regular written tests in class. End-of-module assessments.</p>

Year 6

Main online resource – Pearson’s Studio 1 (Modules 1 and 2)

Module 1 - Talking about likes/dislikes using ‘*J’aime/ je n’aime pas*’, describing and introducing yourself, starting to describe other people, using questions using intonation, connectives ‘*et, aussi, mais*’, using the verbs ‘*Avoir – to have*’ and ‘*Etre – to be*’, adjectival agreement, using the intensifiers ‘*très, assez*’, possessive adjectives, Definite articles (*le, la, les*), present tense of regular ‘-er verbs’, pronouns, talking

Module 2 - Talking about school, school subjects, giving opinions, timetables and food. Using present tense regular “er” verbs, present tense of two irregular verbs “avoir” and “être”, using adjectives and possessive adjectives.

Vocab and Grammar set via Quizlet - details on SMHW. Tasks set via Activelearn. Regular written tests in class. End-of-module assessments

Year 7

Please note: all Year 7 sets will briefly revise the previous unit, prior to moving onto the modules mentioned below

Main online resource - Pearson's Studio 1 (Modules 1-3)

Set 2.H and 2.Set 2 and 3: Module 2 - Talking about school, school subjects, giving opinions, timetables and food. Using present tense regular "er" verbs, present tense of two irregular verbs "avoir" and "être", using adjectives and possessive adjectives.

Set 1: Module 3 - Talking about Free-time, the present tense of '-er' verbs, jouer à, using verbs with nouns and infinitives, using "ils" and "elles", revision of the present tense of the four key verbs '*avoir*', '*être*', '*aller*' and '*faire*'.

Preparation for Common Entrance, introduction of CE papers and questions, with the strong focus on the oral exam. Significant coverage of CE oral exam content – full preparation of first two sections: 'Personal Description, Family, Friends and Pets' and 'School'.

Vocab and Grammar set via Quizlet - details on SMHW. Tasks set via Activelearn. Regular written tests in class. End-of-module assessments

Year 8

Please note: all Year 8 sets may initially be completing their final Year 7 unit, prior to moving onto the modules mentioned below

Set 1, 8.2M and 8.2H: Main online resource - Pearson's Studio 2 Rouge (Modules 1 and 2)

Module 1 – Talking about television, film, reading, using the internet and what you did last weekend. Present tense regular verb endings, revision of the present tense of the four key verbs '*avoir*', '*être*', '*aller*' and '*faire*', using negatives and the perfect tense.

Module 2 – Talking about holidays, understanding tourist information and using the perfect and imperfect tenses.

Preparation for Level 2 Common Entrance. Coverage of CE Oral exam content, eg: speeches and role play. Preparation of third section, 'House and Home' and/or fourth (final) section, 'Free Time'.

Scholars will receive additional material as required

Module 5 - Talking about Holidays and going out, buying drinks and snacks, the present tense of '-er' verbs, using the nous form, expressing opinions, Reflexive verbs, Je voudrais + infinitive, the near future tense, revision of the present tense of the four key verbs '*avoir*', '*être*', '*aller*' and '*faire*'.

Preparation for Level 1 Common Entrance, continued practice of Level 1 CE papers and questions. Coverage of CE Oral exam content and preparation of Level 1 sections, 'Personal Description' and 'School'. (There is no role-play element for the Level 1 CE paper)

Vocab and Grammar set via Quizlet – details on SMHW. Tasks set via Activelearn. Regular written vocabulary and grammar tests in class. Mock exams.
